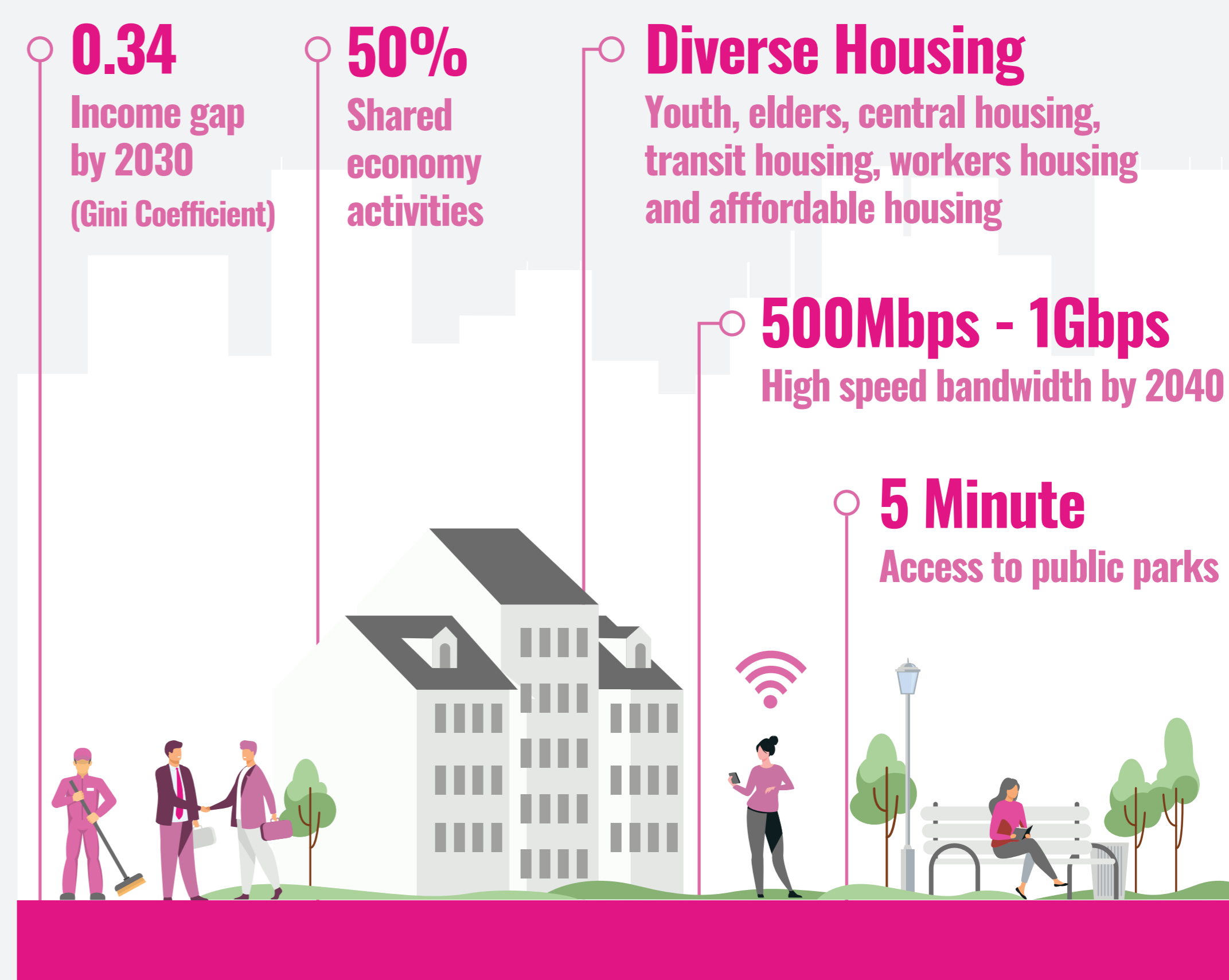
POLICIES AND PLANNING FRAMEWORK
