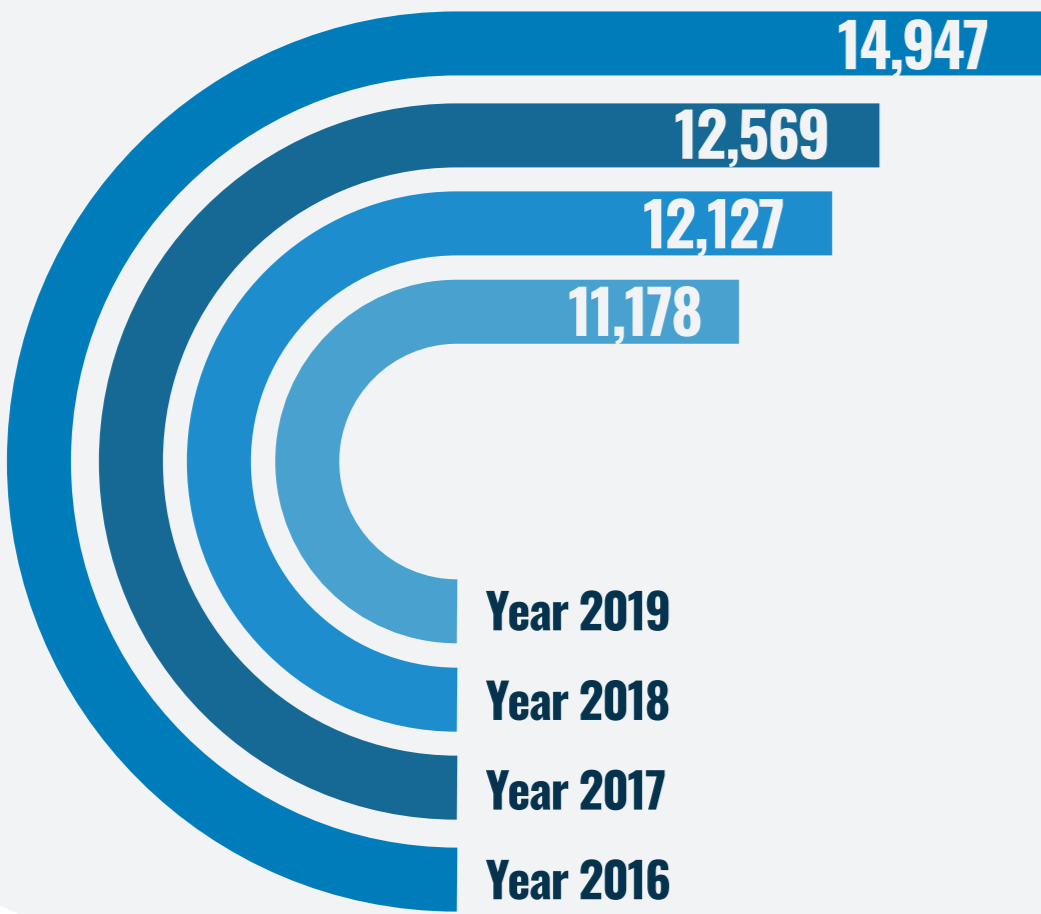
Child Safety Programme: Act Wisely "Don't Be a Victim! (Be Your Own Bodyguard)" For Brickfields Primary School Students.

Collaborated with Malaysian Association For The Blind (MAB) This program is held to ensure the safety of the disabled (visually impaired) in Kuala Lumpur.

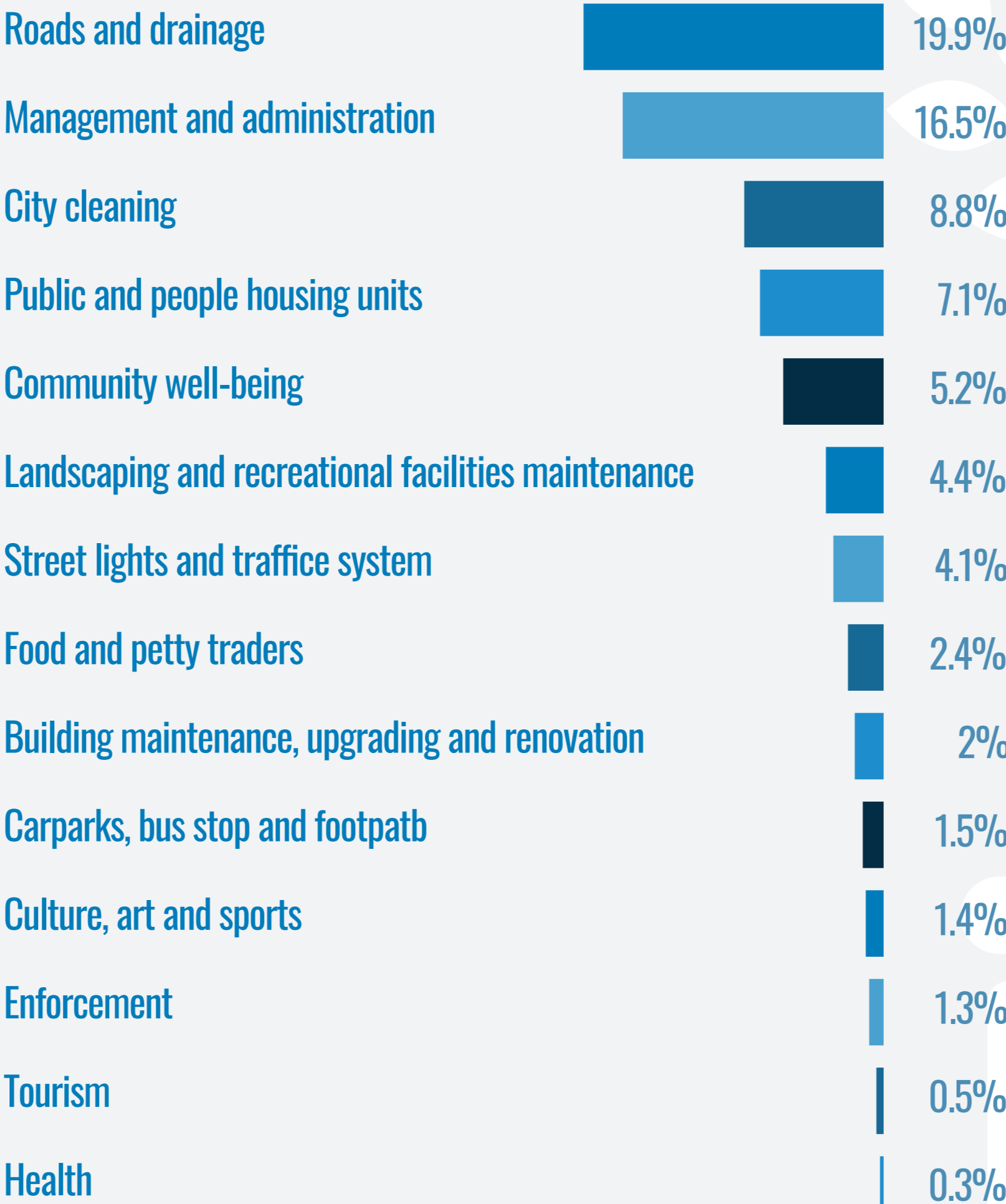
Kuala Lumpur Progress to SDG 16
